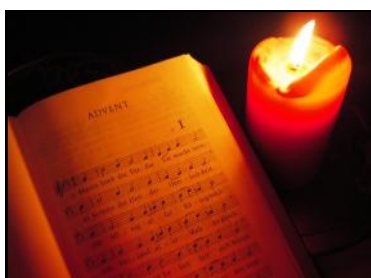


NATIVITY & ADVENT SERVICES
