ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICINES FOR HAY FEVER

As we head into the Summer term and 'hay fever season', we are writing to remind parents/carers that if your child suffers from hay fever or a related Summer allergy, to ensure that any relevant medication is given at home before the school day commences in order to prevent any unnecessary discomfort in school, If your child is a chronic sufferer and needs medication during the day we will ask you to complete a form to confirm the instructions and provide the medicine.

SUMMER UNIFORM

Grey trousers/skirt

St Clement's cardigan/jumper (round neck KS1 v-neck KS2) with school name embroidered on the front

Black/Brown school shoes (not open toed sandals)

Boys

White St Clement's polo shirt or **optional** white shirt & tie (Years 3-6)

St Clement's round neck jumper (KS1) or v-neck jumper (KS2) with school name embroidered on the front

Grey trousers/shorts (not cargo style)

Black/brown school shoes (not open toed sandals)

Please ensure the correct uniform is worn at all times by your child and that **every item** of uniform is clearly labelled.
