Thank you for all your hard work and the delicious meals you cook for our pupils and staff.

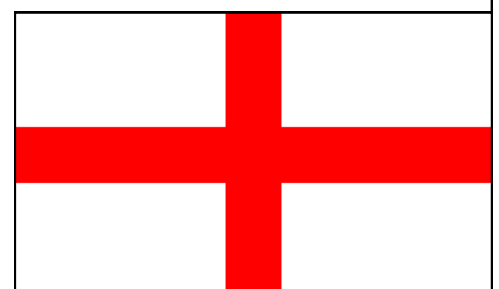


ST GEORGE'S DAY ASSEMBLY
