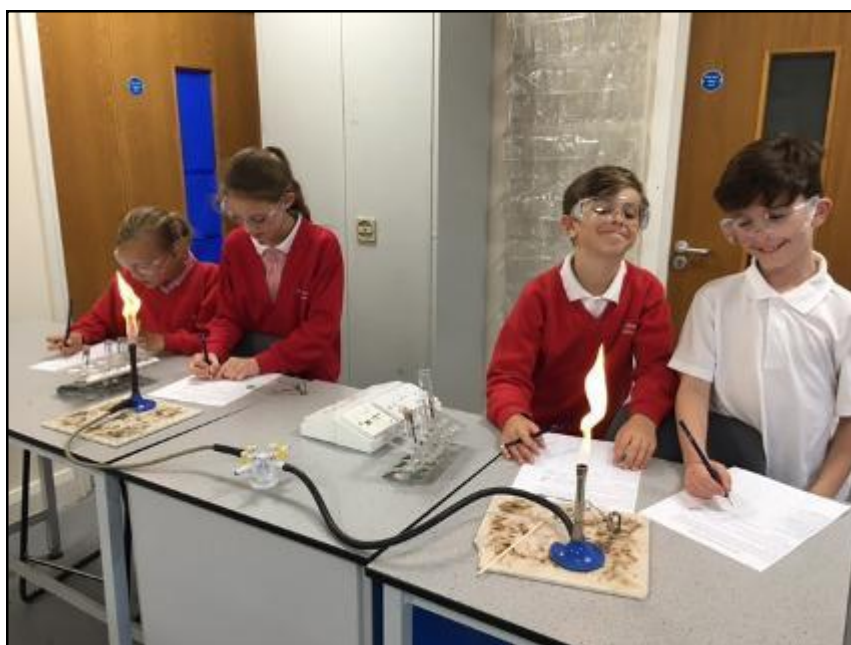
YEARS 3 & 4 FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT
