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### SCHOOL DINNERS

Surrey County Council are increasing their charges for school dinners from September 2016. School dinners will rise from £2.15 per day to £2.20 per day. Children in Key Stage 1 will continue to receive free school meals. If you are entitled to Free School Meals, please contact Mrs Sparrowhawk in confidence.

From September we will not change your child's arrangements for school dinners unless we receive notice by Monday 18th June letting us know if your child wishes to change from packed lunches to school dinners or visa versa. We require a full workings week's notice for any changes. Payments can be made weekly or termly by cash/cheque via the school office or online on ParentPay.

### SUMMER FAIR

Our annual Summer Fair takes place this Saturday, 2nd July from 12.00 noon to 3pm. We would like to thank the Friends of St Clement's for their fantastic work in preparing for this event. We hope the weather keeps fair for us and we look to seeing you there.
