SCHOOL UNIFORM

Children may wear their Summer uniform until the Autumn half-term. Please could I remind you to name all items of children's clothing and equipment when they return to school in September. When purchasing new uniform during the holidays please remember that all jumpers/ cardigans must have the St Clement's logo on the front - jumpers should be round collared for the infants and v-necked for the juniors.

Please ensure your child wears the correct uniform throughout the whole school year— trainers, trainer style shoes or ankle boots are not allowed.

If you are thinking of allowing your child to have pierced ears, please use the Summer holidays to undertake this. This allows for the period when the earrings cannot be removed. Children will not be allowed to wear earrings in school for health and safety reasons and we will follow this up more closely in the coming months as too many children are simply covering their ears with tape and not removing earrings.

Our currently policy allows for red polo shirts in the infants only and states that all white polo shirts, jumpers and cardigans should have the school name embroidered. This is one of the aspects of school uniform that we intend to check much more closely in the coming academic year so please ensure that you purchase the CORRECT uniform as outlined on the school website.
