Listen carefully to the words.</p> 	<p><b>11</b> Find out what the word 'sacrifice' means. What you could sacrifice for someone today?</p> 	<p><b>12</b> What can you share with someone today? Ask God to help you share.</p> 	<p><b>13</b> With your class, pray and reflect on the 5th and 6th Stations of the Cross*</p> 	<p><b>14</b> As a family, pray for those in need this Lent and think of ways you can help them.</p> 	<p><b>15</b> At church today pray for those who are sick, sad or lonely.</p> 
<p><b>16 Sunday's Gospel</b> was Jn 4:5-42* Read it as a class. What does it say about respect?</p> 	<p><b>17 Feast of St Patrick</b> Where was Patrick sent as a missionary of God's love?</p> 	<p><b>18</b> Say sorry to anyone you may have upset and forgive anyone who has upset you.</p> 	<p><b>19 Feast of St Joseph</b> Who was Joseph? What virtues and values did he show?</p> 	<p><b>20</b> With your class, pray and reflect on the 7th and 8th Stations of the Cross.*</p> 	<p><b>21</b> Lent is a special time to say sorry and forgive. What does it say about courage?</p> 	<p><b>24 Feast of St Oscar Romero</b> Find out why Fr Romero was made a saint.</p> 	<p><b>25</b> Keep an eye out for someone who needs some help this week.</p> 	<p><b>26</b> Eggs are a symbol of new life. How does this link to Easter?</p> 	<p><b>27</b> With your class, pray and reflect on the 9th and 10th Stations of the Cross*</p> 	<p><b>28</b> Tell a family member about the Stations of the Cross and why we pray them in Lent.</p> 	<p><b>29</b> At church today thank God for all the beautiful things he has created. Pray that you may care for them all.</p> 
<p><b>30 Sunday's Gospel</b> was Jn 11:1-45* Read it as a class. What does it say about love?</p> 	<p><b>31</b> What bad habit could you give up this week? Who could help you?</p> 	<p><b>1 APRIL</b> Make someone smile today and share God's Joy with those around you.</p> 	<p><b>2</b> Find out why hot cross buns are symbols of Easter.</p> 	<p><b>3</b> With your class pray and reflect on the 11th and 12th Stations of the Cross*</p> 	<p><b>4</b> Invite a family member to sit quietly with you and Jesus in prayer.</p> 	<p><b>5 Palm Sunday</b> At church today thank God for being in our world.</p> 
<p><b>6 Sunday's Gospel</b> was Mt 21:1-11* Read it as a class. What does it say about hope?</p> 	<p><b>7</b> Today we remember how Judas made a bad decision. Ask God to help you make good choices this week.</p> 	<p><b>8</b> Today Jesus planned his last supper. Thank God for your food and pray for children who are hungry.</p> 	<p><b>9 Maundy Thursday</b> Why does the Pope wash the feet of others today?</p> 	<p><b>10 Good Friday</b> Sit quietly, be still, and thank Jesus for showing us how to love.</p> 	<p><b>11 Holy Saturday</b> Today we wait as Jesus lies in the tomb. Tomorrow we celebrate as Jesus rises to new life.</p>
