Children will be learning to:

- Improve their instant recall (mental maths)
- Place value
- Classifying numbers
- Ordering and comparing numbers
- Rounding
- Roman Numerals
- Negative numbers
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiples and factors
- Square numbers and prime numbers
- Multiplication and division
- Written and mental methods for the four operations

Rapid recall facts:

- I know decimal bonds to 1 and 10
- I know the multiplication and division facts for all times tables up to 12x12

Ourselves

In this topic children will learn that God created us in his own image and likeness. They will look at the qualities God wants us to use.

Life choices

In this topic children will be learning about marriage, commitment and service. They will learn that when a couple marries, they are married in the eyes of God.

Hope

Children will learn about Advent, the time when Christians wait in joyful hope of Jesus; the promised one.

Judaism

Children will be learning about the Jewish faith and how Jewish people celebrate Shabbat (the Sabbath).

English

Children will be exploring:

Classic Fiction

Biographies and Autobiographies

Reading and learning poems

Grammar - punctuation, nouns, noun phrases, contractions, etymology, homophones, homographs, dashes, brackets, subordinate clauses, determiners, direct speech, indirect speech and adverbs.

Spellings - give out on Thursday (Test the following Thursday)

Children should spend at least 20 minutes on their homework and should try and complete it as independently as possible.

History

Children will be looking at the Ancient Greeks in more detail. They will look at where they came from, democracy and the Olympics, Battles and Wars, Gods and Goddesses.

Geography

Place knowledge/comparison - UK and Greece

French

Greetings, name, age, numbers, all about me, family, celebrations, actions, body parts and colours.

Science

Earth and Space

In this unit, the children will be looking at the movement of the Earth, Sun and Moon and will identify and compare their relative sizes and shapes. They will also learn about Earth's rotation, day and night, the seasons and the apparent movement of the Sun. During this unit, they will also explore the moon's phases, stars, our solar system and the planets within our solar system.

Forces

Children will look at gravity, friction, air and water resistance and mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and gears.

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Music

Each unit covers all skill areas - Listening and appraisal, musical activities (games), singing, playing instruments, improvisation, composition and performance.
