R.E

Transformation

Children will explore the meaning of the transformation and how it celebrates the Spirit's transforming power.

Freedom and responsibility

They will learn about the commandments and explore how they enable Christians to be free and responsible.

Science

Animals including humans

The children will learn about the changes that take place as humans develop to old age.

Living things and their habitats - life cycles

In this unit, the children will describe the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds and describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

History

World War II

The children will be learning about several aspects of World War II including: The Outbreak of War; Evacuation; Rationing; The Role of Women, The Holocaust; Key Events.

Geography

The children will be learning about geography in our locality connecting to the events of our History topic of World War II.

Art + Design

We will be continuing our work learning about different artists and using them as inspiration for our own artwork. This term we will also be exploring how we can use oil pastels to create different effects.

Children will be learning basic vocabulary linked to: travel, weather, numbers, dates, likes and dislikes, animals and sports.
