During our writing lessons we will be exploring:

Science

- **Sound:** we will investigate how sounds are made through vibration and look closely at the make-up of the ear. We will learn about patterns between pitch of sound and features of the object producing it. We will also investigate sounds over distances.
- **Animals including humans:** we will learn about the functions of the digestive system in humans. We will look at types of teeth and how we protect them. We will also investigate food chains and food webs.

Topic (History and Geography)

The Vikings - areas covered include:

- Why did the Vikings come to Britain?
- How did they travel
- How did the Vikings who settled in Britain lived?
- What were Vikings warriors like?
- Exploring artefacts
- Viking Gods

Human and Physical Geography:
