## R.E

### Transformation

Children will explore the meaning of the transformation and how it celebrates the Spirit's transforming power.

### Freedom and responsibility

They will learn about the commandments and explore how they enable Christians to be free and responsible.

# Summer Term Curriculum Information Year 5 Tigers 2023

## Science

### Animals including humans

The children will learn about the changes that take place as humans and animals develop to old age.

### Living things and their habitats - life cycles

In this unit, the children will describe the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds and describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

## History

### **What does the census tell us about our local area?**

Investigating local history during the Victorian period, children carry out an enquiry using census and factory records. They learn about the changes to a family over a period of time and suggest reasons for these changes, linking them to national events. Planning their own historical enquiry, they research a local family or street.

## Computing

### **Creating media: Stop motion animation**

Storyboarding ideas, taking photographs and editing to create a video animation

### **Micro:bit (This was postponed last term)**

We will also be creating algorithms and programs that are used in the real world. Using the 'predict, test and evaluate' cycle to create and debug programs with specific aims.

### **Y 5/6: Safety and the changing body (Cycle A)**

Learning about online friendships and how to stay safe online; drugs, alcohol and tobacco and the influences that others have on us; how to deal with a choking emergency and understanding puberty.
